JUNE TRIRI® BICYCLE RALLY PREVIEW

Our June TRIRI® bicycle rally allows riders to explore rural Indiana through a series of loop rides from a single Indiana State Park. Stay in a beautiful, modern Indiana State Park Inn, with air conditioning and free WiFi, or keep it simple by camping. Routes will take you over hard-surfaced roads on a series of loop rides from McCormick's Creek State Park over four days. Terrain ranges from flat to rolling to hilly. *Routes and mileage are subject to change.*

•**Sunday (20-30 miles).** Arrive at McCormick's Creek State Park dressed to ride, or change in the inn restroom. Pick up your registration packet beginning at noon in the lobby of McCormick's Creek Inn, and then enjoy a warm-up ride before dinner.

•**Monday (32, 51, or 86 miles).** Today's routes will feature a working limestone quarry, limestone headstones, and other sites of interest. Visit Oolitic (formerly known as Limestone, Indiana) on the long loop, home of the Joe Palooka statue. The shortest option, a drive & ride option, will start and end at Karst Farm Park.

•**Tuesday (80 miles, with 57-mile or 20+ mile drive 'n ride options):** The highlight of the medium and long loops is a limestone sculpture garden called The Touchables, filled with art by self-taught carver C.R. Schiefer. All participants will be able to take a self-guided tour of Bloomington and the IU campus, with their beautiful limestone buildings and landmarks, before returning to McCormick's Creek State Park.

•**Wednesday (20-30 miles):** Ride a final loop before departing McCormick's Creek State Park by noon. Stay another night or through the weekend, if you have time, to explore the area.

PARKING & ACCOMMODATIONS

All participants are responsible for paying a one-time entry fee as they drive into McCormick's Creek State Park. The rate is \$5.00 for Indiana vehicles, and \$7.00 for out-of-state vehicles. Wristbands issued in the rider packets will serve to grant admission to the park when participants are on bicycles.

For those staying at Canyon Inn, showing a room key to the gatehouse attendant will allow you to re-enter the park by car, if needed, after your arrival. Parking is available at a lot in front of Canyon Inn. For campers, one hang tag per vehicle will be issued at the gatehouse,

which will allow you leave and re-enter the park by car for the duration of the rally without incurring additional fees.

Campers will be in the large field next to the swimming pool, with the pool house open 24 hours. Parking is available in the lot in front of the pool.

Campers requiring electricity (such as for a CPAP machine) or wishing to camp in an RV will need to reserve and pay for a Class A campsite with an electric hook-up prior to the rally. The cost for a Class A campsite is \$22.88 + tax per night. For reservations, visit <http://indianastateparks.reserveamerica.com/>.

MEALS

Breakfasts (3) and **dinners** (3) are included and served in the inn dining room. Menus are carefully planned for nutrition and variety, and include options for vegetarians and diabetics. Route maps indicate where meals or groceries may be purchased.

SERVICES

Massage therapy will be available for an additional fee during the rally from Valerie Wimsett. Reserve your sessions prior to TRIRI® (email vwimsett@yahoo.com or phone 812.240.0344). You can also sign up on a first-come, first-serve basis during the tour.

SAG vehicles will be available for support on the route each day. Mechanical support will be provided by area bike shops. The closest shops are in Bloomington, 20 minutes east of the park.

Please arrive with your bicycle already tuned up and ready for four days of riding. We will provide the addresses of local bicycle shops should you need mechanical assistance; you will be responsible for transporting your bicycle to Bloomington for service. We are planning a **beer garden** (indoors) for Monday and Tuesday evenings. Indiana craft beer and non-alcoholic beverages will be offered at this social gathering.

PREPARATION

Any type of bicycle in **good working condition** is welcome. Though most of our participants ride road bikes, many with hybrids, recumbents, trikes, and tandems participants in our events happily. Southern Indiana terrain is rolling to hilly, so be prepared to pace

yourself, and be ready for some climbing. We find that many people enjoy the lower gears provided by a triple crankset or a compact crank.

Plan to carry items you will need during the day's ride, and to eat lunch at a location of your choosing along the route each day. **Bicycling helmets are strongly recommended!** Make sure they are CPSC approved and properly adjusted to fit your head. Riders must be in good physical condition and trained sufficiently for this event.

REGISTRATION & CANCELLATION

All participants must register by Monday, May 10.

You will receive a confirmation postcard within two weeks after you register; contact us if you do not receive one. The Participant Newsletter is available for download at your convenience at www.triri.org. Registration packets, with your maps for the entire week, will be available for pick-up just prior to the ride. No packets or maps will be mailed out in advance of packet pick-up.

Youth ages 4-9 will be \$120 per youth, and children 3 and under will be \$65 per child.

Please note that Indiana child safety laws requiring restraint seats make it illegal for our support vehicles to transport children 7 and under; Therefore, all **children transported by bicycle** must be at least 8 years old. Younger children are welcome if a member of their party is registered as a Driving Participant and acts as their personal SAG each day. *In all cases, minors (anyone under the age of 18 years) must be accompanied by a supervising, registered adult, and that adult must be identified on the minor's registration form.*

Cycling/Driving Participants: Your registration fee includes

- a commemorative polo shirt
- 3 breakfast and 3 dinner buffets
- two evening beer gardens
- Indiana State Parks camping or inn fees
- 24-hour access to showers & restrooms for campers
- SAG support
- massage therapy availability
- maps and marked routes.

All cancellations must be in writing (email is acceptable), and received by May 10. Those who cancel by this deadline will receive a refund of their registration fee minus \$60.00/person.

No refunds will be given after May 10 for any reason. Trip cancellation insurance is available from McKay Insurance at 800. 942.0283.

I, the undersigned, freely acknowledge and realize the dangers of participating in the June TRIRI® Bicycle Rally; (June TRIRI® Rally) and fully assume all risks including, but not limited to, collision with pedestrians, vehicles, other riders, sponsors, promoters, or drivers, and dangers arising from falls, road surface, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment, weather conditions, as well as the possibility of physical and/or fixed or moving objects, the negligence of other riders, as well as the possibility of physical and/or mental trauma (or injury). I understand that the route requires bicycling on public roadways and in bad weather and that cyclists have been hospitalized and/or killed because of traffic mishaps that are either their responsibility or others' responsibility, and I further agree that I will bear all expenses incurred in any such accidents. I realize that the June TRIRI® Rally requires physical conditioning, and I represent that I am in sound medical condition. I have no physical or medical impediment which would endanger myself or others. I understand and agree that a situation may arise during the June TRIRI® Rally which may be beyond the control of the sponsors, promoters or organizers and agree to ride so as not to endanger either myself or others.

I waive, release, discharge for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives (including successors), any and all rights and/or claims which I have, may have or may hereafter accrue to me against TRIRI®, the sponsors and promoters of the June TRIRI® Rally including the Indiana Department of Natural Resources and each individual state property, J & B Event Management and its employees, K & M Events and its employees, or other sponsors or affiliated organizations and their respective agents, officers and employees for any and all damages, injuries or claims which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly arising out of my participation in the June TRIRI® Rally, including any vehicle I have parked in the space provided at McCormick's Creek State Park. I agree that if I or anyone on my behalf makes a claim against any of the releases, I will indemnify, save and hold harmless each of the releases from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage or cost which may incur as the result of such a claim and any claims will be filed in Monroe County, Indiana.

I give my permission to the organizers to use my name and any photographs, videotapes, motion pictures, recordings, TRIRI® Diary articles, evaluations or any other record of my participation in the TRIRI® tour for any publicity and/or promotional purposes without obligation or liability to me.

I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my bicycle. I understand it is strongly recommended that I wear a properly fitted, CPSC approved bicycle helmet on my head at all times while on my bicycle, and I will carry water and personal identification at all times and agree to abide by the rules of the June TRIRI® Rally. The above agreements and representations are my express understandings of the risks, and I assume these voluntarily and freely without coercion or duress. This agreement may not be modified orally and may not be waived in any respect.
